## Food and Nutrition Services

Assists families and individuals based on income and assets to purchase food with an EBT (electronic benefits transfer) card.



### Maximum Income Guidelines

### SNAP (Simplified Nutrition Assistance Program)

SNAP is designed to deliver food assistance to elderly individuals receiving SSI. SNAP is simplified version of Regular Food & Nutrition Services. To be eligible for SNAP, individuals must be 65 or older, receiving SSI, purchasing food separately (1 person household), living in own place. Income and deductions does not impact SNAP allotments, only shelter cost.

## Applying for Food and Nutrition Services

An application and an interview must be completed to receive Food and Nutrition Services. You will need to provide certain items to prove you qualify for Food and Nutrition Services. You must be a U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident in order to receive Food and Nutrition Services.

### Eligibility Documents Required

(not all inclusive)

- Identification
- Social Security cards for all persons applying
- Rent/Mortgage lease or receipts
- Utility bills
- All checks stubs for the previous 2 months (if working)
- Receipts for paid child support
- Cancelled checks or receipts for child/adult care expenses
- Medical bills (if elderly or disabled)

If possible, bring in or send with your application. If you can't get all of these items, please apply anyway. You can provide information after you apply and the caseworker can help if you need assistance.
