CitiSculpt is a mixed-use, commercial, residential and institutional real estate development company headquartered in Charlotte, NC. CitiSculpt partners with land owners, municipalities, institutions, investors and other developers to shape communities. CitiSculpt has partnered with Durham-based MHAworks architecture firm for development of properties CitiSculpt owns in and around Downtown Durham.

CitiSculpt would like to present a proposal for redevelopment of the County's parking lot at 500 East Main Street which supports the Health and Human Services Building.
