- Increase access to community-based treatment programs upon release

Next Steps:

- Train Peer Support Specialist
- Develop Media tool to promote within the health system
- Begin implementing program May 1, 2019
- Train Detention Center Staff on Buprenorphine Waiver Certification
- Begin implementing 4-tier approach program
- Refer patients to the FIT (Formerly Incarcerated Transition) and STARR (Substance Abuse Treatment And Recidivism Reduction)
- Participate in the recently awarded Planning Initiative to Build Bridges Between Jail and Community-Based Treatment for Opioid Use Disorder
