The Board met in closed session to discuss matters relating to the location or expansion of a business or industry pursuant to G. S. 143-318.11(a)(4).

Deputy County Manager Carolyn Titus briefed the Board on a request by EMC Corporation, a leading developer and provider of information infrastructure technology, solutions, and services, to receive an economic development incentive to expand operations in Durham County by building a new Tier 3 Data Center and R&D facility. EMC is proposing to lease a building in Durham County, invest \$280 million, and create approximately 280 new jobs. Ms. Titus gave the Board a virtual tour of EMC's website.

Kim Simpson, Tax Administrator, briefly discussed taxes paid and current tax revenues, and projected new revenues from the project.

Ms. Titus recommended that the Board offer \$1 million over a 5-7-year period

The Board reached a consensus to direct staff to offer \$1 million as a base incentive and up to \$1,000 for each Durham resident's training expenses for a total of up to \$1.2 million incentive.

The Board also met in closed session to review the revised Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding between the County of Durham and S. Chuck Kitchen, County Attorney.

The Board and County Attorney Kitchen discussed the revisions made to the Agreement.
