

Who qualifies for CBI?

18 years of age and older

Involved with the Criminal Justice System

Able to read/write

- CJRC has a contract with NCDPS to provide CBI to High Risk/High Need adults on probation, parole, and post release supervision.
- CJRC accepts referrals for the TASC (Treatment Alternatives for Safer Communities)
- CJRC accepts referrals from court as part of a diversion agreement or deferred prosecution. (Include link to attached form)
- CJRC accepts referrals from Federal Probation
Referrals must be received from appropriate referral source prior to services.

About CBI classes:

- Available mornings, afternoons, or evening
- Meet twice weekly
- Each class last 1.5 hours
- Can be provided in 24 (standard), 16, 12, or 8 sessions
- Virtual classes available for some participants
