2. Approval of September 21, 2022 Meeting Notes (MPO)

Doug Plachcinski made a motion to accept the September 21, 2022 Durham Staff Working Group (SWG) Meeting Minutes. Jay Heikes seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Plan Updates

a) Durham County Transit Plan (MPO)

Aaron Cain stated that an overview of the recommended Durham County Transit Plan (DCTP) will be presented at the Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan (DCHC MPO) Technical Committee (TC) and Board meetings prior to its release for a 21-day public comment period. Aaron Can said that the DCTP Phase 3 outreach efforts were presented to the MPO Board and TC during their last meeting cycle. Aaron Cain shared the details to the upcoming presentations for the MPO Board, Durham County Board of Commissioners, and GoTriangle Board.

b. Transit Governance Study (Durham County)

Chair Ellen Beckmann stated that the Transit Governance Study (TGS) is proceeding, that the Interlocal Agreement (ILA) is in the process of being finalized, and that consultant Adam Howell is expected to have it available for Board review in November. Chair Ellen Beckmann said that the Durham County TGS is being coordinated with Orange County's efforts, and Aaron Cain shared the Orange County Transit Plan's key approval dates.

c. Wake-Durham Bus Plan (GoTriangle)

Jenny Green shared that the Wake-Durham Bus Plan is currently planning public engagement efforts for February and March 2023. Jenny Green said that concepts and transit schedules through various corridors are being investigated for FY25-27, and that consolidation of bus routes to Durham are expected.

d. Commuter Rail (GoTriangle)

Steven Schlossberg provided an update on the Greater Triangle Commuter Rail project, which included information about the FY24 Work Plan for Wake County, as well as scenario planning.

4. Budget Amendment Request – Three New Positions for Transit Construction Project Management (City of Durham)

Chair Ellen Beckmann introduced the City of Durham's (COD) budget amendment request for three new positions for transit construction project management. Aaron Cain said that this request is for a budget amendment only, and that it will require review and approval from other Boards before it is included in the Work Program. Doug Plachcinski asked for clarification on the COD's financial commitment, and Sean Egan replied that the COD will commit 50% to salaries and fringe benefits.

Aaron Cain stated he will work with Tom Devlin to include missing financial information within this

5. FY24 Work Program Schedule and Project Sheet (MPO)

Aaron Cain provided an update of the FY24 Work Program Development Schedule. Aaron Cain stated that the MPO will be setting up meetings with all transit agencies to discuss project submissions for FY24, that project sheets are due to the MPO by December 9.

Sean Egan asked if the SWG was continuing to investigate if it should be identified and act as a public body. Aaron Cain replied that the SWG is currently being recognized as such in the draft ILA. Sean Egan asked if the SWG was interested in moving forward with public body status before the draft ILA is adopted, and members agreed that it would moving forward.

Doug Plachcinski recognized Chair Ellen Beckmann and Durham County for their recent 2022 Public Technology Institute Solutions Award for their work on the draft DCTP.
