AT THE CONVENIENCE SITES

Durham County operates and maintains three staffed convenience sites listed on the back of this brochure. Residents must display a current Solid WasteDecal in order to use these services. Solid Waste Decals are issued on a fiscal year basis and are included with your real estate tax bill which is mailed in late July/ early August. To purchase a decal, contact the Durham County Tax Office at 919-560-0300.

These convenience sites are for unincorporated residential waste and recycling only. The sites DO NOT accept commercial waste or construction and demolition waste.

AT HOME

Durham County also provides curbside collection of recyclables for unincorporated residents every other week. Each home is issued one green 96 gallon recycling cart. For a current recycling schedule, download the free Durham County Recycles app or visit our website www. dconc.gov/recycling. If your home does not have a recycling cart, call 919-560-0433 to request one.


